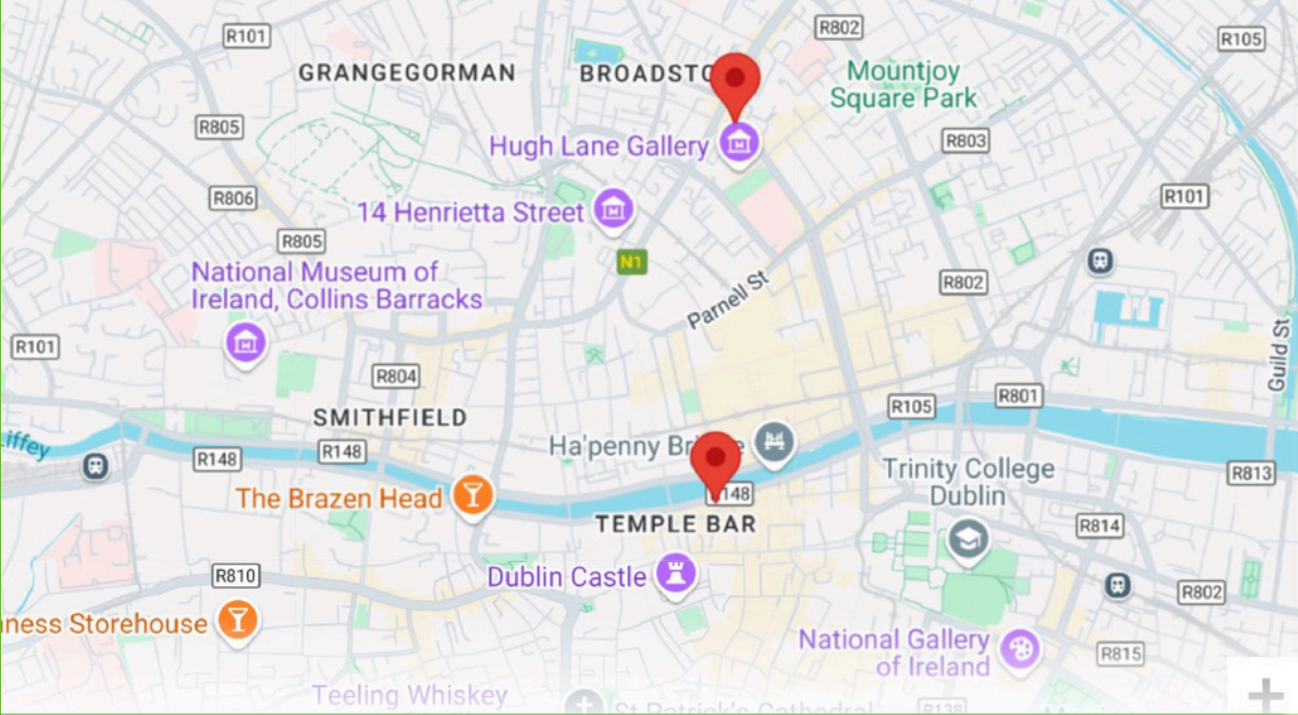

Use this guide to understand where you are now and where you can go:

Level	Name	Description
Below A1	Beginner	You only know a few words with very limited understanding.
A1-A2	Elementary	You can understand and say a few basic things.
Pre-A2	Pre-Intermediate	You can communicate simply in familiar situations, though with some difficulty.
A2-B1	Intermediate	You use basic tenses and vocabulary, but complex grammar is challenging.
B2	Upper-Intermediate	You communicate fairly well but still make mistakes and misunderstand at times.
C1	Advanced	You speak and understand well but may occasionally struggle with precision.
C2	Proficient	You speak and understand very well, with only rare difficulty in unfamiliar contexts.

Our IELTS preparation course is designed for students aiming to study or work in English-speaking environments.

The IELTS exam is one of the most recognised English language qualifications worldwide and most universities require a score of 6.0 or higher.

In this course, you will:

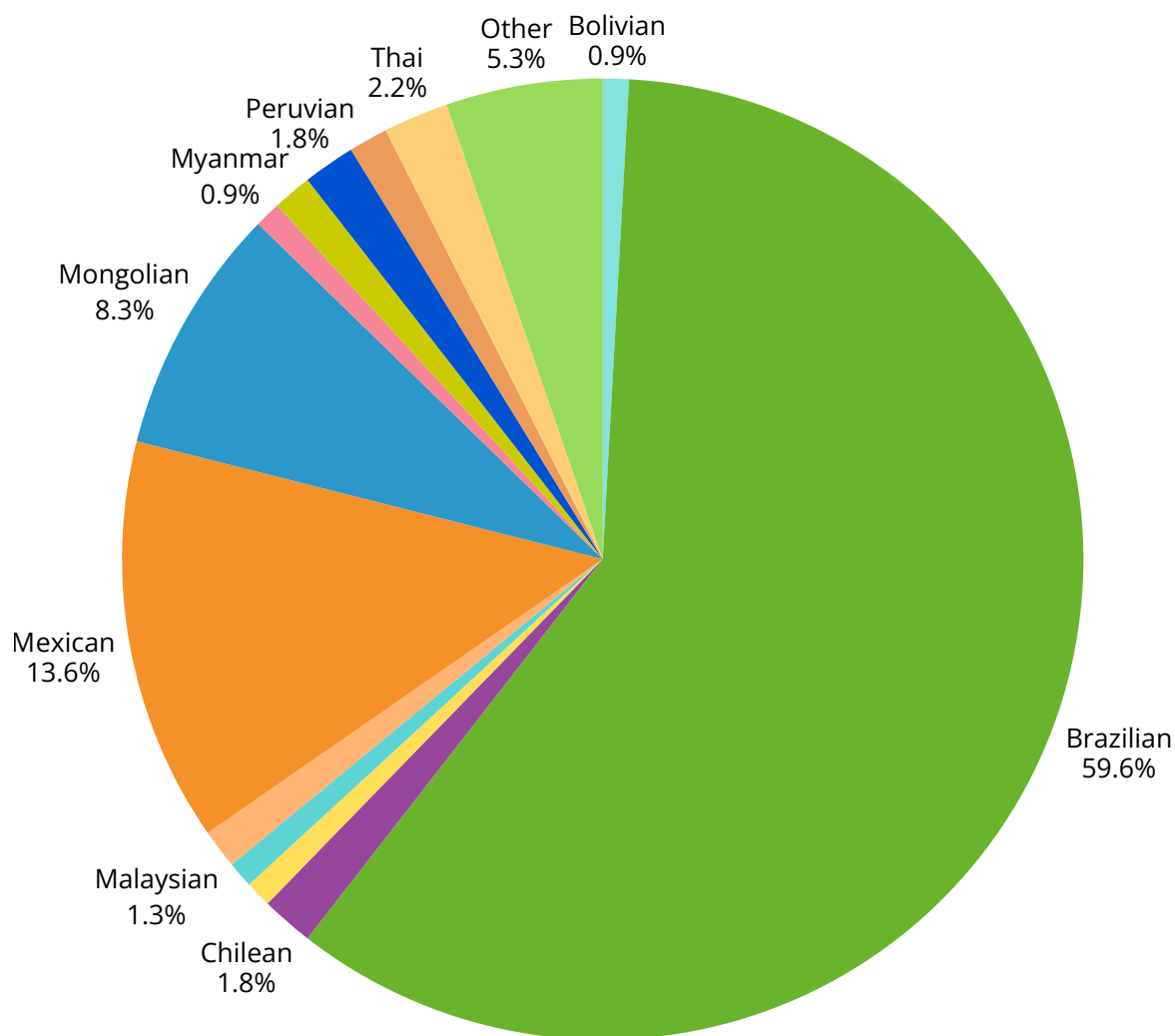
- Practise all four exam components: Reading, Writing, Listening, and Speaking
- Gain familiarity with the exam format and task types
- Learn strategies to complete each task efficiently within the time limit
- Participate in exam simulation days to build real exam confidence
- Receive individualised feedback to target specific areas for improvement

You'll also receive regular progress updates and support to ensure you're on track to achieve your desired score.

Please note: An upper-intermediate to advanced level of English (CEFR B2/C1) is required to join this course.

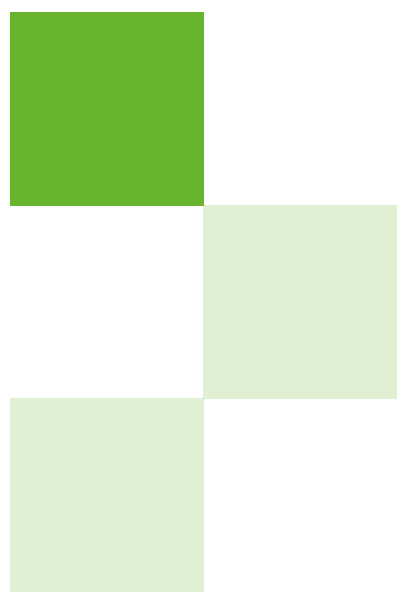
